

Directions to Putt's Camp

Drive north on interstate 83 to interstate 76 (Pennsylvania Turnpike)

Drive west on the turnpike to the Breezewood exit.

Drive west on route 30 to Everett PA.

Take route 26 north from Everett PA to Route 913.

Take route 913 to Saxton PA.

Go through the town of Saxton PA to a sharp left turn just past the Exxon station.

Make this left turn (route 913) and continue on until you come to a left turn leading to a power company plant.

Make a left turn down this road and continue until you come to the Weavers Bridge which crosses Raystown Lake.

.Do not cross the bridge. Look to the right and you will see the locked access gate to Terrace Mt. Trail. The Gate Combination is _____.

It is highly recommended that you have a four wheel drive vehicle to go beyond this gate. If you feel as if you may have trouble, contact someone at the camp and we will come out and bring you into the camp.

Terrace Mt. Trail is three and ½ miles of dirt road with areas of water to go through, hills to climb that are steep switch backs with slippery surfaces, trees and other debris will be in the trail. It is a single lane trail and if you meet someone going the other way, someone will need to back up and find a spot to pull off the trail in order to allow the other vehicle to pass.

Do not park a vehicle in a manner that would block access in and out of this gate.

Do not ever leave this gate unlocked!

Unlock the gate, drive through the gate, allow no one else to pass through the gate, and lock the gate after you have passed through it!

Drive back Terrace Mt. Trail about three miles until you come to a fork in the trail.

There you will see a small sign pointing to the left fork for Putt's Camp.

The left fork will bring you to the camp in about ½ a mile.
