Parking at Pavilions is strictly prohibited. Unloading & loading of vehicles is permitted.

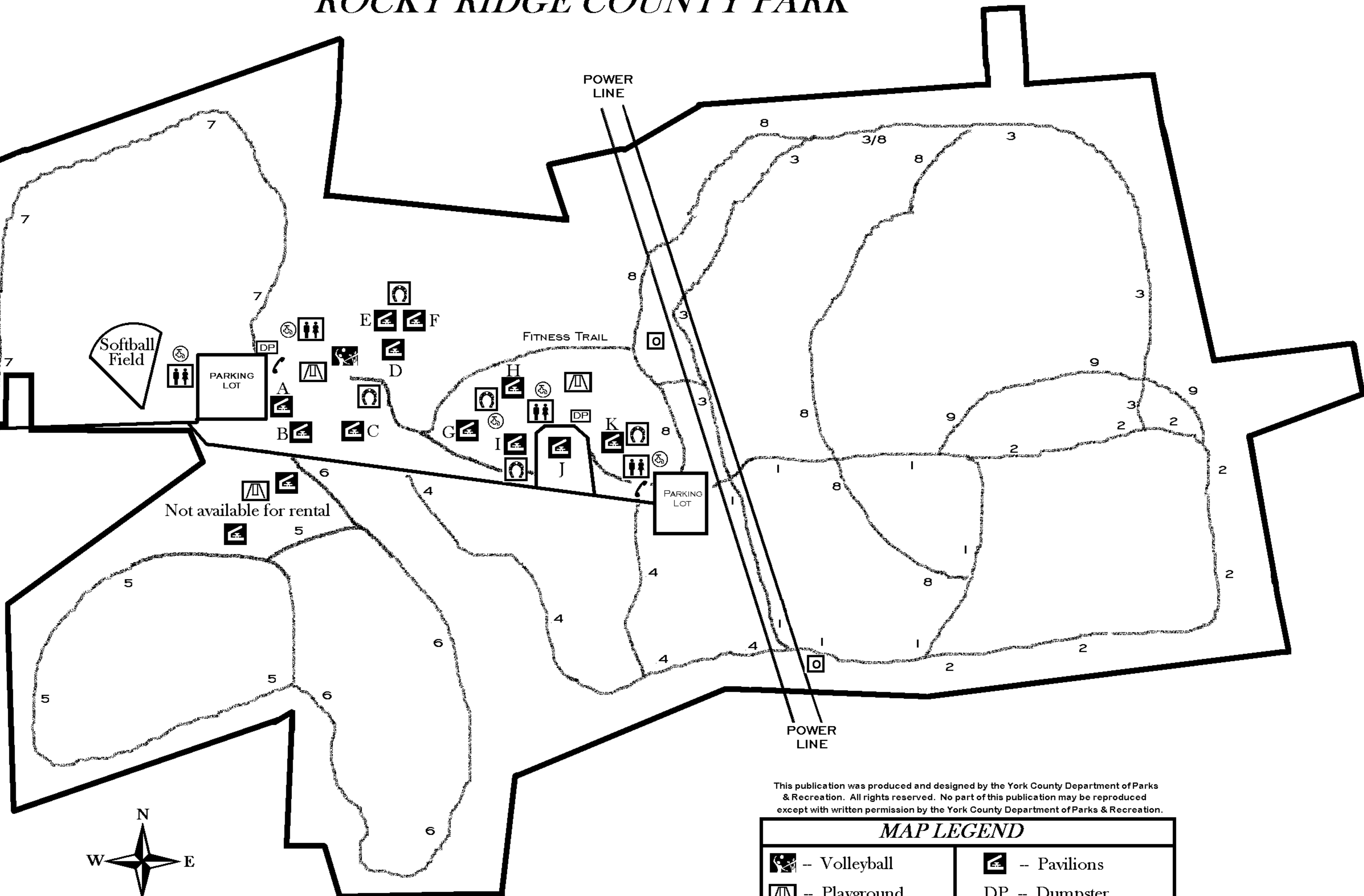

- WILDLIFE AND PLANT LIFE SHALL BE LEFT UNDISTURBED.
